

# 25 *Awesome Ideas to Spend Time with God*

Your time with God can be exciting! **Change up your routine** once in a while with some of these awesome ideas. **Mix, match, and blend ...** or do whatever tickles your fancy!

- [1] **Go for a walk in nature or visit a beach, lake, river, or mountains.** You can stand in awe of God's majesty, power and wisdom.
- [2] **Start a garden.** By gardening, many spiritual truths can come to life.
- [3] **Write and sing a new song/poem to God or sing contemporary songs or hymns.** Use your creative talents to worship God or borrow from others (like me!).
- [4] **Dance to your favorite gospel music.** You can take it a step further by choreographing a dance. Why not?!? Feel His presence as you dance in worship to Him.
- [5] **Study God's Word.** God will always speak through His Word.
- [6] **Take an online Bible course.** It will open up your understanding; give new insights and foster greater appreciation for God.
- [7] **Use your artistic skills (coloring, drawing, painting, etc).** God can speak to you as you ponder and paint. 🎨
- [8] **Have breakfast with God (or any meal for that matter!).** Since God is with you, why not spend time with him as you would a friend ... over a meal? Have a little tête-à-tête with God! 🍳
- [9] **Play songs on a musical instrument.** If you have no instrument, your hands will suffice.
- [10] **Reserve one day weekly for resting and connecting with God.** This idea has two important aspects: (1) celebrate that you are saved by God's grace (and not by your good works) and (2) remind you that God will cause you to prosper and not your own busyness.

**[11] Do a prayer walk at home.** It will help add passion to your prayers and you're less likely to fall asleep. No more 😴 while you 🙏.

**[12] Create a prayer room (war room) or prayer area in your home.** This can help you to disconnect from everyone and everything; remove distractions and concentrate on God.

**[13] Set up prayer stations in your home.** You can move from point to point with pre-assigned areas for adoration, confession, Scripture reading, journaling, confessing sins, prayer requests, etc. Decorate and furnish accordingly.

**[14] Focus on the names and attributes of God.** By studying these, you will see how marvelous He is.

**[15] Memorise and meditate on Scripture.** This is one of the most important spiritual disciplines for life transformation.

**[16] Pray the Word.** If you're at a loss for words when you're ready to pray, open your Bible and begin to pray the Word of God. The book of Psalms is a good place to start, but don't stop there.

**[17] Journaling (prayer journaling, scripture journaling and love-letters-to-God journaling).** For the prayer journal, write down your prayer requests and keep a record of His answers. *"The faintest ink is more powerful than the strongest memory."* (Chinese proverb)

**[18] Use a devotional.** The Daily Bread is a popular devotional guide, but there are many others that will help you to grow spiritually.

**[19] Use a Bible reading plan.** Strengthen your relationship with God with a regular daily dose of Scriptural medicine using an online Bible plan or devise your own. You might also want to try reading aloud.

**[20] Confess your sins to God.** Regularly clear out any debris that might be clogging your connection with God.

[21] Read an inspirational book written by a faithful follower of Jesus. 📖 This is like a form of modern discipleship without the direct personal touch, but it is still effective.

[22] Pray with others. Praying with other believers can move mountains! 🙌

[23] Fast (food, social media, entertainment, and the like). Fasting helps with knowing God's direction; getting a breakthrough; fostering humility; engaging in spiritual warfare; cultivating discipline, and many more benefits.

[24] Spend a day with the Lord (at least monthly) and extend it to a few days for a retreat (at least yearly). Disconnect from all information and communication technology and give attention to building intimacy with God. You can also add a time for silence and solitude (just you and God!).

[25] Use a book of prayers (like [The Valley of Vision: A Collection of Puritan Prayers and Devotion](#)) or other prayer resources. You can learn a lot from these written prayers while deepening your own prayer life.
